

LETTER OF CONFIRMATION TO THE BLENDING COWORKERS  
FROM THE CHURCHES IN EUROPE

As leading brothers in Europe we are writing to express our oneness with the blending co-workers in their marking of those who are causing divisions and causes of stumbling at the present time in the Lord's recovery.

During our annual gathering for fellowship in Malaga, Spain, 6-7 December, those of us present read together the warning concerning Brother Titus Chu and those promoting his divisive teachings with much consideration and prayer. We recognise the need to keep a watchful eye on such ones and to cease interaction with them, and that according to Titus 3:10 such factious ones, after being repeatedly admonished as they have been, should be refused and rejected. This is not to excommunicate them, but to quarantine them for the sake of the entire Body of Christ.

We also agree to admonish the saints not to read the materials published by them in any form, because such materials are filled with questions and contentions of words that will cause the readers spiritual sickness and death.

Furthermore, we wish to testify that there is no global organisation controlling the churches in the Lord's recovery, but rather there is the genuine fellowship of the churches for the real and practical building up of the Body of Christ.

We also testify that the churches in Europe are supplied and nourished by the ministry of brothers Watchman Nee and Witness Lee, which we believe is the ministry of the age and which is being made available to us through the publications of Living Stream Ministry.


We affirm that there should only be one publication work among us, so that there is no uncertain sounding of the trumpet in the Lord's ministry. This was Brother Nee's pattern that Brother Lee continued and taught during his ministry. We recognise that to have different publication works will bring confusion and destroy our morale in warring the good warfare.


We believe that the seven annual feasts, which were Brother Lee's bequest to the Lord's recovery, have been a very great benefit to us, keeping us all up-to-date in the Lord's speaking and in one accord for the Lord's move on the whole earth. The Holy Word for Morning Revival which follows these feasts has been a wonderful supply to all the saints;


